1-year position, 5-10 hour commitment per month

- Serve as a liaison between the Art Therapy Graduate School and the art therapy profession, community, and organizations
- Attend monthly board meetings

Formal Description (per ByLaws)

- 1. A volunteer position requiring a commitment of at least 7-10 hours of work per month.
- 2. A member of VATA and is a student in good standing at an Art Therapy program in Virginia.
- 3. Will act as a liaison between VATA and the Virginia Art Therapy Student Community (to include and not limited to identified VATA Student Liaisons).
- 4. Expected to participate in monthly board meetings (No less than 75% of the time) and maintain regular contact with the board regarding meetings, board related business, and VATA events.
- 5. Support VATA in recruiting new members and act as an advocate for the student body as needed.
- 6. Will participate in community outreach events and/or VATA sponsored events (VATA board representatives may be asked to lead an event committee).
- 7. Student Representative(s) will be appointed by the board.
- 8. Student Representatives will be mentored by the President and Vice President.
