

Student Representative(s)

1-year position, 5-10 hour commitment per month

- Serve as a liaison between the Art Therapy Graduate School and the art therapy profession, community, and organizations
- Attend monthly board meetings

Formal Description (per ByLaws)

1. A volunteer position requiring a commitment of at least 7-10 hours of work per month.
2. A member of VATA and is a student in good standing at an Art Therapy program in Virginia.
3. Will act as a liaison between VATA and the Virginia Art Therapy Student Community (to include and not limited to identified VATA Student Liaisons).
4. Expected to participate in monthly board meetings (No less than 75% of the time) and maintain regular contact with the board regarding meetings, board related business, and VATA events.
5. Support VATA in recruiting new members and act as an advocate for the student body as needed.
6. Will participate in community outreach events and/or VATA sponsored events (VATA board representatives may be asked to lead an event committee).
7. Student Representative(s) will be appointed by the board.
8. Student Representatives will be mentored by the President and Vice President.
